comply if approached to give samples. If they refuse, that refusal will be

treated as a positive result. Written consent must be provided for

juniors by parent/guardian signing the entry form.

Equipment Inspection: Equipment inspections will take place on both days

Masters/Cadets: Please indicate if you would like to enter as a Cadet or a Master as per

World Archery Rule 4.2.

Masters will shoot the appropriate distance for their category as per

WA Rule 4.5

Cadets may shoot the relevant Archery GB Metric Round as per Archery

GB rule 308 - please note this on the entry form Changes to entry category will not be accepted.

Refreshments: There will be teas and coffees available to purchase throughout the day

Photography: No un-authorised photography at this event. Please register with the

organiser on the day if you wish to take pictures or video.

Awards: Medals will be awarded at the end of each day. Trophies will be

awarded based on performance over the whole weekend.

All prizes will be awarded according to entries at closing date.

Bosses / Faces: As much as possible Danage Bosses will be used, non Danage bosses

will only be used as required for barebow/longbow/recurve archers.

The WA 50m round will be shot on individual 6-zone faces.

50m/30m (or cadet/master equivalent) distances of the WA 1440 will

be shot on individual 6-zone faces for Recurve and Compound.

50m/30m (or cadet/master equivalent) distances of the WA 1440 will

be shot on full 80cm face for Barebow and Longbow.

Ends/Timing: The shoot will be run to WA Rules using the Danage system of

timing and lights. The WA 50/60/70m will be shot in two details - four per Boss. The WA 1440 will be run in Single detail, 3 archers per Boss.

Camping: Available at the school at £5 per unit / per night, with hard standing for

a caravan. Site has water and toilets, but no shower.

Alternatively there is full camping and facilities at Fakenham

Racecourse.

Parking: Parking is available at the venue, with disabled parking available on the

field itself.
